

The Need to Coordinate Against Natural Disasters

When natural disasters occur, most sectors of the country, as well as other nations and international organizations want to contribute with humanitarian assistance and reconstruction, because that is our true nature, we are souls of good will.

However, the lack of organization and coordination cause resources, time and contributions to be wasted, when in an emergency effective, fast and timely action is essential, which is possible, Japan has repeatedly shown us.

Likewise, as time passes, the catastrophe remains in the background due to other events and people dedicate themselves to their daily lives for their survival. Therefore, in the absence of organization, supervision and control of the quality of the implementation of reconstruction plans, they remain half or not done at all and the refugees continue to suffer the same problems until another disaster strikes.






Organization to Guarantee Quality of Response

For these reasons, we recommend the use of our Natural Resources organization chart, which would be located in the quality bureau of the municipality, country, continent or the UN, to ensure continuous supervision, control and correction in the conservation and restoration of natural resources. , sustainable development and action against natural disasters. That is, an organization capable of promoting and guaranteeing continuous improvement, of applying the Japanese Kaizen method.







Committees to Act Against Natural Disasters

In view of the fact that many nations of the world are facing consequences of natural disasters, as a provisional measure in which they can create a Department of Natural Resources, we recommend the establishment of Committees to Act Against Natural Disasters, a National Committee and Regional Committees. Let's take Colombia for example, where different regions have been affected as a result of Hurricane Iota.

Each Committee would be made up of all sectors of society, led by the national government and its regional representative, because in a democracy, it represents the majority and they were elected for the service of the citizenry. This will direct, organize and coordinate all activities, both with national and regional organizations,

They will report both irregular situations, such as deviation, delay in meeting objectives so that failures are immediately corrected, as well as show the successes of the plan, to keep the population involved taking responsibility until the plan is fully implemented.

Regarding the Representative of civil society, consideration should be given to electing the representatives of the affected communities, since they will be a fundamental part in the achievement of the activities to be carried out, throughout the evaluation, planning, action, operation and maintenance process.

Humanitarian Assistance

Humanitarian assistance must be immediate, medical assistance and provide people to meet their basic needs, they mainly lack water, non-perishable food that does not need water or preparation, clothing, kitchen utensils and personal hygiene and of shelters. Nations should be prepared for these eventualities according to their risk and forecast atlas. In case they are not prepared, they should go to international organizations for support, generally the religions, firefighters and the military are the best prepared to provide immediate assistance.





Reconstruction

The reconstruction will be planned based on the evaluation and projection of the desired results towards a sustainable development in guaranteeing human and environmental rights, that is, determining the number of schools, hospitals, water management systems, resistant greenhouses for planting and processing. of food, cultural and sports entertainment, viable economic activities to be developed in the region, to guarantee the right to work, Urban planning according to demographic growth and migratory movements, as well as the construction of a central refuge for the continuous storage of disaster reserves. The constructions must be aimed at reducing vulnerability to natural disasters according to their risk atlas. In the evaluation it is important to consider the available rubble, bioclimatic materials and construction, the structures that withstood the natural disaster, to determine the reason and the way to improve it. For example, drones equipped with terrestrial sensors called LIDAR were used to study why the Chinese wall has resisted hundreds of years and they discovered that it was because they used sticky rice and limestone lime to hold the bricks together, so ancient techniques and the Current technology could be applied to the infrastructures that resisted in order to strengthen them or innovate designs adjusted to the culture of the region,



Ecosystem Reconstruction and Recovery

In reconstruction, techniques and actions must be improved to improve nutrition and to recover ecosystems. The NGO Arca Tierra proposes Vertical Gardens resistant to natural disasters for food production, with a production of 10 times more in proportion to the land and each plant will produce 60% more, through lighting and music systems. This can also be used to recover eroded and desertified soils and reforest areas affected by the natural disaster.

Vertical Garden to produce food with aquaponics and process it, to achieve zero hunger. Or to produce plants and flowers to save ecosystems and eroded or desertified soils







Obtaining Funds for the Implementation of These Solutions

There are different funds that nations can access for sustainable development and to comply with the Treaty of Paris to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, given that the previous proposals, to rebuild the region affected by a natural disaster, Just like the Island of San Andrés, it is through buildings and infrastructures that reduce greenhouse gas emissions and are aimed at achieving sustainable development, Colombia or another affected country will be able to access these funds, among which Climate Action stands out. of the European Union, Special Fund for Climate Change (FECC), GEF Environment Fund, Least Developed Countries Fund (FPMA), Green Climate Fund (GCF), Adaptation Fund (FA), Fund Special Development Fund (SDF) They support the reduction of risk to natural disasters and climate change, Blue Moon Fund, Infrastructure Fund (Infrafund), Clean Technology Fund (CTF) (par of the Climate Investment Funds) promote a larger scale of financing for the demonstration, deployment and transfer of low-carbon technologies with significant potential for long-term savings of greenhouse gases, Nordic Development Fund, Prototype Fund Carbon Fund (PCF), Biocarbon Fund, Community Development Carbon Fund (CDCF), Italian Carbon Fund, Dutch CDM Fund (NMDLF), Danish Carbon Fund (DCF), and so could continue listing funds to those that Colombia could access to finance the development and use of these solutions. In addition to funds, they can also go to foundations, in the case of reforestation of mangrove forests and creation of natural anticyclone barriers through mangroves, to SEACOLOGY, WETLANDS INTERNATIONAL and to the United Nations program of BLUE CARBON.


